Even if you have just started using Photoshop©, Robert’s teaching methods will show you how to make Photoshop’s© power work for your studio.

This is a hands-on class and work files will be provided so you can follow along with the lessons.

You will need your own computer with the current version of Photoshop© installed. Please make sure that your computer is working and is trouble-free.

You must have adequate free space on your hard drive to copy the lesson files to your computer.

A graphics tablet such as a Wacom© is highly recommended; if this is not possible you will need to bring a good optical mouse.

You should also bring the installation disks for your operating system and Photoshop©. This could allow you to recover from a system crash.
